The Cal Batllet winery was created in the year 2000 by restoring the old family winery situated in Gratallops. Its production comes exclusively from the growing of the family-owned vineyards, some as much as 100 years old, cultivated on hillsides with slate soil placed in Gratallops and Torroja del Priorat. The grape varieties grown here are the local Carinyena and Garnatxa in reds mainly, and the old Escanyavella in whites. All the wines are classified under the distinctives "Vi de VILA" and "VI de PARATGE" from the wines pyramid classification regulated by de DOQ PRIORAT, clearly committed with a philosophy of terroir wines, expressing all the personality from each village where we have our roots: Gratallops and Torroja.

100% carinyena N.

Aged for 16 months in french oak.

New 225 l barriques 100%.

Production 285 bottles. 14,78 % vol. ATT 5,81 g/l tart.

Torroja property: Ronçavall (slope 300m, SW).

Spontaneous fermentation in wide vessels with 2 pigiage per day, maximum temperature 24°C, soft extraction, 30-day long macerations and high control. Respect for fruit.

A 100% Carignan wine from our family-owned Ronçavall vineyard. The bush vines were planted 75 years ago on steep slopes by our mother's father. This wine expresses the unique character of this single vineyard in Torroja del Priorat. Elegant and delicate, full-bodied, fruity, silky, well balanced, fresh and with a long finish... charming.

The 2019 harvest with extreme temperatures in June, and small rains, represents a ripe and round year, gives us the conditions to get ripe, fine, elegant wines but with a balanced acidity.

The Priorat wine appellation is made up of 12 villages, with 459 "paratges" (every different area conforming the villages), the "NOMS DE LA TERRA".
