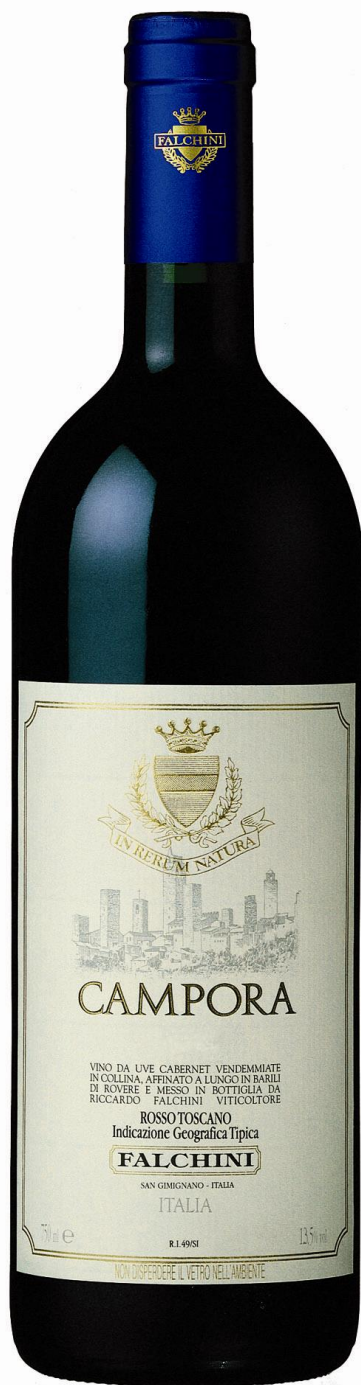


# Azienda Agricola Casale - Falchini

## ROSSO TOSCANO I.G.T. - CAMPORA

### INDICAZIONE GEOGRAFICA TIPICA

This world renowned wine comes from the Camporaiolo vineyard at Casale in San Gimignano. It is almost entirely produced from carefully hand selected Cabernet Sauvignon grapes. After the fermentation it passes into 225 l. French oak barriques and is aged for at least 24 months; this is where the wine gains the structure and the elegance it is noted for. The wine then rests in the bottle for a minimum of 2 years in the cellar before being introduced to the public. The Campora is a wine with great harmony and a remarkable structure and complexity.



**Appellation:** Rosso Toscano IGT - Red Tuscan IGT

**Vintage:** 1999

**Origin:** from the property owned vineyard Camporaiolo at Casale

**Grape Varietal:** 95% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Merlot

**Vinification:** The fermentation is done in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks, here the maceration period is about 20 days long. After the malolactic fermentation the wine ages for 24 months in French oak barrels (225 l.). The wine is later bottled and rests in the wine cellar for at least two years.

**Alcohol content:** 13.5%

**Ageing:** Can be refined in the bottle for 10-20 years if stored in a dark, cool place away from light, for a period of time; store bottle horizontally.

**Main features:** deep and intense ruby red. The perfume is fine and wide, with mature berries, vanilla and prunes. Truly mouth filling, with a lengthy build up of flavours that culminates in a satin textured finish

**Best at temperature:** 18°C, decanted at least an hour prior to serving

**Best with:** great roasts of red meats, game and noble cheeses.
